

# Car Park Terms & Conditions

1. The ticket or permit issued is valid ONLY at Hereford Leisure Centre, Holmer Road, Hereford and Leominster Leisure Centre, Coningsby Road, Leominster. It is not valid at any other site operated by Halo or managed by Corporate Services, Herefordshire Council or private operators.
2. Halo cannot guarantee a parking space will always be available to you.
3. It is your responsibility to ensure that your vehicle is legally parked at all times. Vehicles must be parked within a marked bay and without causing an obstruction or inconvenience to others. Should your vehicle not be parked correctly a parking charge notice may be issued. Vehicles parked in the disabled bays must display a valid disabled parking badge.
4. You must ensure that your car park ticket or permit is valid at all times and displayed on your windscreen/dashboard. Failure to display your car park ticket or permit may result in the issue of a parking charge notice and any fees payable.
5. You may not park in suspended parking bays. This will result in enforcement action being taken.
6. Your vehicle must be able to fit within the markings of the parking place and be:
  - a. A passenger vehicle that does not exceed 6 metres in length and can carry no more than 13 people including the driver; or
  - b. A goods carrying vehicle that is no more than 2.44 metres (8ft) high; or
  - c. A motorcycle; or
  - d. An invalid carriage.
7. You cannot park trailers or caravans, whether they are linked up to a vehicle displaying a car park ticket or permit, or standing alone unless prior agreement has been issued by the Halo Centre General Manager.
8. Your vehicle must be roadworthy and have a valid road tax license at all times.
9. Your car park ticket or permit is valid in the vehicle indicated on the pass only.
10. Parking is available when the facilities are open.
11. The car park is monitored by a third party company, any query regarding the issue of parking charge notices should be directed to them as per the information on the reverse of the ticket or on display in the car park.
12. The use of the permit is limited in duration as follows:  
4 Hour Pass - maximum of a 4 hour period in any single visit at any time  
Anytime Pass - unlimited use.
