Who can park in the Bridgnorth Endowed Leisure Centre car park?

Parking is for staff, school visitors and leisure centre customers only.



What are the parking charges?

0 to 15 minutes	FREE
After 15 minutes	£1.00 per hour
Lost ticket	Full charges apply
Halo Members	No charge (<i>Halo will capture members' car registration numbers</i>)
Blue Badge holders	No charge (<i>permits must be displayed clearly and car registration numbers given to Halo</i>)



How does the system work?

An Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) system is in operation at the Bridgnorth Endowed Leisure Centre car park. We will collect and record the car registration numbers of those exempt from payment and other users will be charged accordingly.



When do I pay?

Car park users will pay on foot by entering their car registration number at a machine when arriving.



How do I pay?

The parking machines accept debit or credit card transactions, and car park users will simply pay at a machine on arrival.



Can I leave the car park without entering my car registration number at a machine within the 15-minute grace period?

Yes. The system will recognise that you are within the 15-minute grace period.



Who is exempt from parking?

The following will be entitled to 2½ hours free parking:

- Halo Active members who pay by direct debit
- Children's swimming course customers who pay monthly
- Hirers of school or leisure centre facilities (person named as the hirer only)
- Blue Badge holders



What are the hours of operation?

Charges apply 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (including Sundays and Bank Holidays).
