- Working with other partner organisations (Herefordshire Council) to meet its obligations under ISO 14001

In particular, we will:

- Prevent pollution and minimise waste from our operations
- Make efficient use of natural resources, including energy
- Promote environmental awareness, understanding and capabilities among staff, suppliers and contractors
- Make this policy available for all staff, suppliers, contractors, partners and the general public via induction training, notice boards, direct mail, libraries, website and so on
- Seek to ensure through the budget process that staff have the necessary resources and training to meet the requirements of this policy and the environmental management system
- Set formal objectives, for which named managers are responsible, to build improved environmental performance across our activities
- Develop and manage an environmental management system (EMS) for all activities and services, seeking certification to ISO 14001
- Formally audit the EMS and then review its progress revising procedures, objectives and targets wherever necessary to improve on performance
